

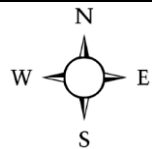

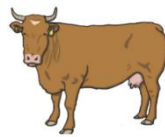

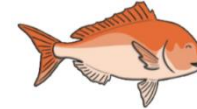

These leaves used to be part of a living thing when they were on a tree, now they have fallen down they are no longer living.

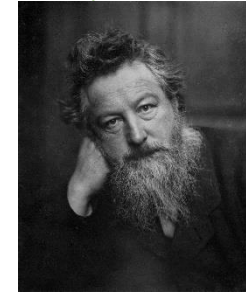
Never been alive
