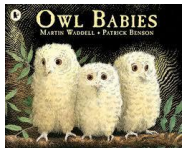
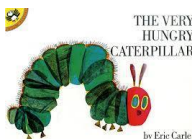
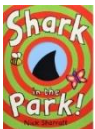
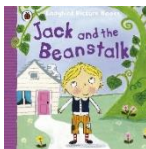
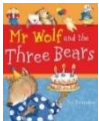


INTENT:
