If not, play Save or Sink to show your support.**

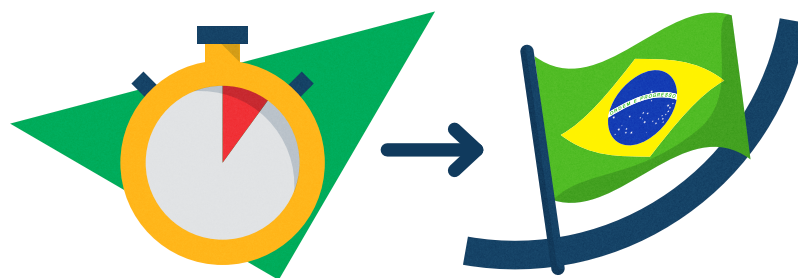
- Spread lots of cards across the space – some face up, some face down.
