Over the years, new sports have been added to the Olympic and Paralympic Games. Look at all of the sports to help you choose what to try.



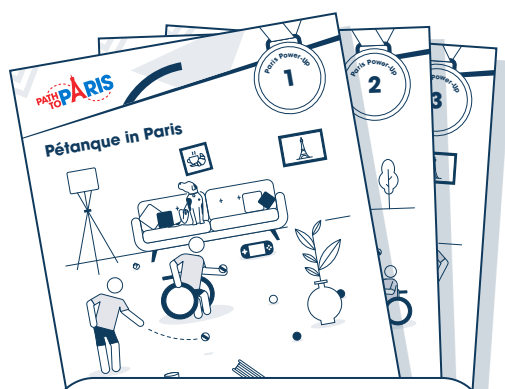
