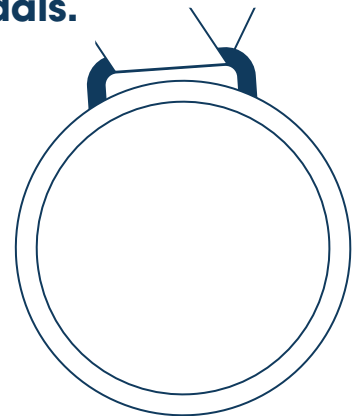
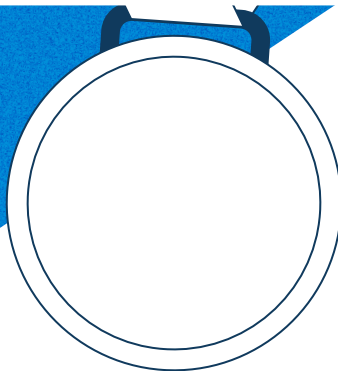
Your London challenge is...

Show how hard you can work by playing 'Gold Rush'.

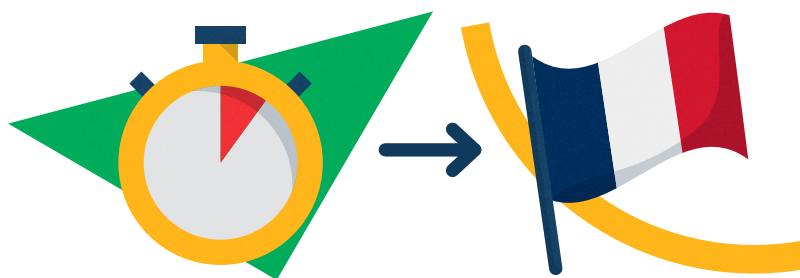
- Scatter the balls across the area.
