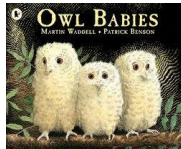
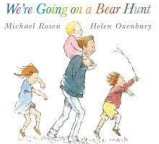
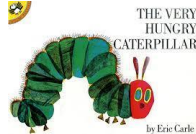
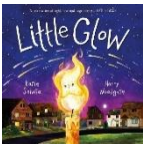
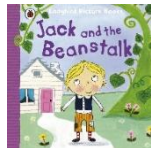
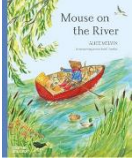
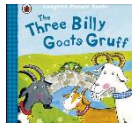
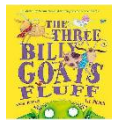
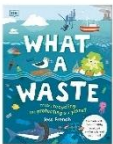
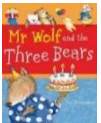
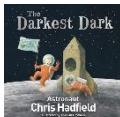


INTENT:
